

Are you **sexually active** and **unmarried**?

You're breaking the law.

Among consenting adults of any gender, North Carolina law prohibits:

- Promiscuity, or “indiscriminate sexual intercourse”¹**
- Habitual intercourse²**
- Anal sex³**
- Oral sex⁴**
- Occupying a hotel room with a non-spouse “for immoral purposes”⁵**
- Sex for hire, except masturbation⁶**

1. North Carolina General Statute 14-204. **Punishment: Class 1 misdemeanor, up to 4 months in jail, no maximum fine.**
2. North Carolina General Statute 14-184. **Punishment: Class 2 misdemeanor, up to 60 days in jail and/or a \$1,000 fine.** (At least three or four weeks of “some association” may be required to prove habitual intercourse.)
3. North Carolina General Statute 14-177. **Punishment: Class 1 felony, up to 5 years in jail.**
4. North Carolina General Statute 14-177. **Punishment: Class 1 felony, up to 5 years in jail.**
5. North Carolina General Statute 14-186. **Punishment: Class 2 misdemeanor, up to 60 days in jail and/or a \$1,000 fine.**
6. North Carolina General Statute 14-204. **Punishment: Class 1 misdemeanor, up to 4 months in jail, no maximum fine.**
